The Caerphilly Miners Community Centre Management Committee

Part of the Caerphilly District Miners Hospital is a building called The Beeches which was bought by the Rhymney Valley miners in 1923 to be used as the first hospital in the area to serve miners and their families. The miners gave 6d out of their weekly wage of

12s 6d to raise the £30,000 needed to buy and maintain the building.

The Management
Committee is working
to ensure that The
Beeches is preserved
for the benefit of the
community once the
hospital is closed. The
rest of the site will be
used for housing.



Achievements in the last 12 months

- Some of our members have been on a Herian Course to learn about how to promote the project as part of our cultural heritage.
- We have carried out three surveys and obtained the views of nearly 200 people
 - We have set up and formalised our committee
 - We have made submissions to the Local Development Plan
 - We have secured funding from UnLtd and from the Key Fund for ongoing work

Since being formed in 2008 the Management Committee has already done a lot to ensure that the building will be preserved but still have a long way to go before its future is set in stone.
